

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED for the Independent Home Visitor Scheme

Many carers of relatives with learning disabilities worry about who will visit their loved ones when they are no longer around. The aim of this scheme is



to build up a relationship which supports the best interests of a person with a learning disability who has little or no contact with friends or relatives.

Regular visits to them in their own home provides social contact and forms an on-going

and long-term relationship. Home Visitors encourage clients to address any concerns and will support them by seeking help from other professionals.

If you have experience of working with people who have a learning disability or have been a carer, why not become a volunteer for the Independent Home Visitor Scheme?

Volunteers will need to be reliable, sensitive, understanding and have good communication skills. The role involves working unsupervised and so a good level of initiative and professional conduct is required.
