THE MENCAP ENTERPRISE initiative started earlier this year with the Gardening & Maintenance group meeting each Tuesday followed by the Makers & Bakers group on Wednesdays. Both these groups operate from the Mencap Centre in Portswood. They were developed as part of the vision to move away from the traditional 'day service' offer so that people with learning disabilities could be engaged in real work based activities and through this gain a sense of self-worth. Through the

overall programme offering cooking based skills, gardening, maintenance, creative arts, and core business skills, learners are empowered and by our dedicated team of professional tutors, staff and volunteers.

Our vision for the enterprise programme is to open up pathways for people with learning barriers to employability opportunities, whether it be in a voluntary or a paid capacity. More importantly and at the very heart of the programme is the intention to upskill them and help boost their confidence and self-esteem. Their contributions to the society in which they live are being recognised and valued as an asset to the community.

CARERS NETWORK MEETINGS are for anyone to attend if they provide unpaid care to a son, daughter, brother, sister or a relative with a learning disability of any age.

The first meeting held in November put the spotlight on respite. The group heard from Nick Bryant who has been leading on a review of what is available in the City and how to improve the offer. This is an issue most carers feel strongly about, particularly in making sure that they and the person they care for are able to have regular breaks from each other with the confidence in knowing that this meets their individual circumstances. Future meetings will focus on suggestions made by carers based on their lived experiences. Speakers on specific topics identified will be invited for the first part of the meeting only allowing time for carers to meet and get to know each other informally.
